

# "PROOFS OF ISRAEL - XXXIV"

## "The Kingdom of God is at Hand"

*Scripture: "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand.  
Repent ye, and believe the gospel." **Mark 1:15***

Since there are several different "interpretations" of the above scripture extant in the Christian Church today, it is incumbent upon us to "rightly divide"<sup>1</sup> the scripture and give you the correct one!

A false teaching is called a "heresy" in the Bible, and since there is only one correct (true) teaching, it follows that others are heresies!

The favorite false teaching of the "Establishment Church" preachers of this scripture is: "The Kingdom of God is within you."

So they teach that our Lord had reference to "A spiritual Kingdom", since it is within you, and not a literal King I am complete with King, etc. How wrong can you be?

Let one introduce you to a Bible, which your preacher has never told you about! It is the Ferrar Fenton Bible, and it is the only Bible translated from the original manuscripts directly into the English language and for English speaking people! Mr. Fenton, an Englishman, spent 50 years of his life completing this work, and he translated this same one verse as "the Kingdom of God is among you!"

Incidentally, most biblical marginal references to this verse, uses the same word as does Fenton's Bible. "Among" rather than "within." "Among" is not the same as "within."

Jesus – Christ, the "King" of His God's Kingdom, certainly was "among" the people – rather than "within" them therefore, the "Kingdom of God (He is God in the flesh) was at hand."

Now Israel, God's Chosen people, who were "given ears to hear & eyes to see, and whom God had driven west, now occupied countries from the Black Sea to the "Tin Isles." (England)

They had lost their language, and their identities as Israelites as punishment for "backsliding" into the worship of Baal.

However, they were given "eyes to see and ears to hear" both his miracles & his message! (Gospel)

Therefore, he tells us, if you believe him, that he "came only to the Lost Sheep of the House of Israel," and he chose 11 of his Apostles from the tribe of Benjamin in Galilee (all Israelites) and only one "Jew" named Judas, who lived in Judea. (An inhabitant of Judea. (A geographical nomenclature!)

After training these Apostles in his teaching of "The Kingdom of God is at hand," he sends them on the road, and commands them (**Matt 10:6**) to "go only to the Lost Sheep of the House of Israel." And that is where they went. They preached to Romans, Galatians, Corinthians, Greeks, etc. who were bloodline Israelites! They saw, they heard, and they believed, and because the founder of all of these so-called Gentile Christian in all of the places mentioned in the New Testament where the early Church was formed.

The fact that God chose them, came to them, they believed him, "turned away" from their sins, formed the Churches and sent the Gospel (good news of Christ) to the 4-corners of the world, should be all the proof needed to prove that they were/are Israel.

We submit that this is another "Proof of Israel," and it makes much more sense than the story the "Establishment" Church tells about the Jews being Israel, God came to them and "they just did not believe in Him, so Jesus sent the gospel out to the Gentiles." Folks, this is a "bare faced lie" as:

The heresy of the "Establishment" Church teaching that the Kingdom is spiritual rather than a terrestrial kingdom negates three years of teaching, by both Jesus and his Apostles that "The Kingdom of God is at hand."

All that one needs to rectify this contradiction and make our Lord's words fit his actions is to go to your K.J.V. Bible and check out the marginal reference given for the word "within." You will find the word "among you" given there!

We all agree that Jesus is the "King of Kings, and Lord of Lords"; but few there are who realize the Kingdom and the throne is located -- and there must be a Kingdom, a throne, and a King or Queen presiding over it "who are the seed of David." And it must have been in continuous existence from King David (The tribe of Judah), through Jesus Christ, down to the present time!

Our Lord placed many "birth marks" on his people, Israel (not Jews) if we would just look for them. Here are several that fit only one race of people on earth – the conclusion being – they must be Israel!

Remember:

Jehovah-God chose Abraham, his son, Isaac and his son Jacob. He changed Jacob's name to Israel. (Meaning he who rules with God)

He gave Jacob twelve sons, whose progeny became "the children of Israel." God chose Judah, one of the 12 sons to be his "Kingly Tribe." In other words they would produce the Kings and Queens of Israel and rule over them. (**I Chron 28:4**) "There will never lack a man to rule over my people Israel."

We conclude by pointing out that we have given ample K.J.V. Bible scriptures straight from the finger of God to prove that he chose a race of people known as Israel, that they would be ruled by Kings and Queens 'from the seed of David' in everlasting Kingdoms, they would receive 'Divine Rights.' (Magna Charter – Bill of Rights)

As they lived in "the Isles and Coast-lands" of the world, they would be a "Commonwealth of Nations," and "a great and powerful nation."

Fellow Anglo-Christians, I present to you the British people living in the "Isles and coastlands of the sea" and their American cousins who peopled the U.S. of A.

Listen:

- "BRITH" = the Hebrew word for covenant!
- "ISH" = the Hebrew word for man!
- "BRITISH" = "Covenant Man living in Covenant land.

And their full blooded cousins are also the "Covenant People" living in the "New JERUSALEM, governed by God's laws, and they speak a new language ENGLISH which is derived completely from the HEBREW<sup>2</sup> language.

Our God is a discriminating<sup>3</sup> God. If you believe that he is sovereign – HE CAN CHOOSE, ELECT, MAKE, etc. Whatever and whomever he chooses. Therefore:

1. He chose Abraham
2. He Chose Isaac (Son)
3. He chose Jacob (Grandson)
4. He chose Jacob – Israel's 12 sons (Great Grandsons)
5. He chose the son, Levi (Levites) to be his priestly tribe.
6. He chose the son, Benjamin, to be the "Light bearers."
7. He chose the son, Joseph, to produce two sons Ephraim and Manasseh?
8. He chose Ephraim for the "BIRTHRIGHT" or leader, over all Israel. **Gen 48:13-20**
9. He chose to make a "Company, (Commonwealth)" of nations out of the Ephramites.
10. He chose Manasseh to "become a great and powerful Nation.
11. He placed these Nations (Israel) "over all other nations of the world!"

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Now Folks if you want to get the exhilarating feeling of seeing both covenants and prophesies of Jehovah-God's fulfilled to the letter and revealed for the first time before your eyes – read on:

Some four thousand (4000) years ago, Jehovah-God chose Father Abraham from among a race of Hebrew people and made a covenant with him. He gave him a son Isaac, and gave Isaac, a son Jacob, and extended Father Abraham's covenant to include all of them! All of these chosen people were Hebrews.

Then God changed Jacob's name to Israel<sup>4</sup> gave Israel twelve sons and thus was born the "Children of Israel." God's covenant was extended to these children, and of them he covenanted, "As long as the sun, gives its light by day, and the moon and the stars by night, there will always be an Israel, and I will always be their God!" (**JER 31:35-36**)

One of Abraham's sons was named Judah, and God chose him and his seed to furnish the Kings and Queens who would "rule over Israel," his chosen race of people. (**I Chron 28:4**)

"There will never lack a man to wield the **sceptre** over the house of Israel."

Then in circa 1500 B.C., God chose David, a mere shepherd to "rule" over the tribe of Judah, and he quickly brought all of the other tribes within his kingship, and thus for the first time the term "Israel" incorporated all 12 tribes.

Then out of the tribes of Benjamin and Levi, sprang the "Priest," and "Light bearers."
