### Deut 4:32-34:

"For ask now of the days of the past, which are before thee, since the day that God created man upon the earth, and ask from one side of here an unto the other, whether there hath been any such thing, as this great thing is, or hath been heard like it?"

"Or hath God assayed to go and take him a nation from the midst of another nation, by temptations, by signs, and by wonders, and by war, and by a mighty hand, and by a stretched out arm, and by great terrors, according to all that the Lord your God did for you in Egypt before your eyes."

### "A Nation and a Company of Nations"

The above scriptures are completely fulfilled by the following scripture, and as we will show is fulfilled by the Commonwealth of Great Britain and the U.S.A., and no other countries; or people, in the History of the world that can, and has, completely fulfilled the prophesy of Moses, God's own man!

### A Nation out of a Nation

The Prophecy: "A nation, and accompany of Nations, will come out of thee ..." **Gen 35:11**

Not taught in the Establishment Church are these Scriptures and their fulfillment. If they did, they would have to tell you that they absolutely do not fit the Jews, and therefore, they are not God's chosen.

You see, Jacob-Israel made their prophecy in Egypt where he had and "All Israel" had gone to reunite with their son, (and brother) who was chief administrator to the Pharaoh (Leader) of Egypt, and who had married an Israelite daughter of the "Priest of Or," and bore him two sons – Ephraim, and Manasseh. (Ephraim being the younger.)

The brothers of Joseph, had all become the progenitors of the "12 tribes" of Egypt, both with Joseph there were only 11 tribes. Subsequently, Israel (Jacob) called his son, Joseph and his two sons to his bedside and find in **Gen 48:13-14** the following passage of scripture.

## "PROOFS OF ISRAEL - XXXIII"

Joseph's son Manasseh was the elder, therefore should have received the "birthright" (the leader of the 12 tribes); but God had other plans, and Israel placed his right hand on the head of Ephraim (the younger) and gave him the birthright and who was predicted to become, "a company (commonwealth) of Nations." Folks, a "Commonwealth" is not an "Empire." There have been numerous Empires, i.e.: the Roman, Ottoman, Medes-Persian, British, Greeks, etc., but only one "Commonwealth" – that of the English people. The nations within a Commonwealth, all have the same race, the same language, the same religion (God), etc, and other things in common! However, there has been one "Commonwealth," and that of the white, English speaking, Christian Nations. (People) what other "Proofs of Israel" (not Jews) do we need?

So we have here, a nation of people, the English, who were "pulled out of other nations (people), such as the Anglos, Saxons, Danes, Normans etc., etc., and became a "company of Nations," certainly fulfilling this portion of the Lord's promise to Ephraim.

Then Israel told his grandson, Manasseh, that he would sire a nation (people) that would become a "great and mighty" nation. This of course, was fulfilled when the pilgrims, all who came from out of white countries (Israel) and send them to the "New World" to build a "great and mighty Nation," thus fulfilling the prophecy "a Nation, coming out of a Nation" which was made to Manasseh, the elder son of Joseph. **Gen 48:13-20**

To reiterate:

The word British, is a Hebrew compound word:

Brith = covenant

Ish = man

Here we have then "Covenant Man." The word Britain is also a compounded Hebrew word:

Brith = covenant

Ain = land

Folks, it continues to get better! We now have "covenant man" living in "covenant land." Again we say, nowhere else in history can we find this to be true!

As we say, colloquially, "on top of this." We find this "commonwealth" of people (British) gaining their "brethren," in witnessing to the "whomsoever," with our Lord's message of hope for the world! Approx. 98% of the missionaries come from England and the U.S.A. and 95% of the printed Christian literature!
