

# "Race, or Religion?"

(Which did God Choose?)

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In order for the "Establishment Church" to be able to preach and teach the absolute heresy that the "Jews are the Chosen race of God, it becomes necessary that they extricate the scriptures which deal with race from the Bible. This, they have done. In order to camouflage these myriad racial scriptures with another heresy that "THE CHURCH IS NOW ISRAEL." The Jews themselves, made this tact necessary; because they claim to be "only a religion after all." To attempt to straighten out this gross error, it is necessary for us to determine whether or not God chose a race (seed) for "his glory" here on earth...or did he choose a religion? If God chose a race, and Biblical proof cries out that he did, then the Biblical truths herein propounded, will unequivocally establish the fact that it was not the Jew. Once this is established, then the remainder of the Bible will take on a new meaning and understanding to you. You must, however, have "ears to hear, and eyes to see."

Some Christians seem to believe that God would be unjust if he selected someone, something, or some race to carry out a purpose or design of his here on earth! Seldom does a thought seem to be given to the fact that God is omnipotent, and as "the potter is to the clay", he cannot be unjust, and he cannot be unmerciful! He cannot lie! He accounts to no one. He created light and darkness. He created gravity. He created the heavens and earth. And as far as we know, God chose it over all other planets on which to create life. He "formed" Adam, and made Eve from Adam's rib.

So God chose to make man, and he chose to make him in his image. God also chose to make races of men with different skin color, intellect, and, of course, talents! My dear Mother used to say "I don't worry about the weather, that's God's business." Well, it is high time that we adopt this attitude toward Jehovah. If God wanted to make men of different color, abilities, or different in any way, whatever, that is his business! He is sovereign. He can, and did do it! The Creator does not answer to the Created! Therefore, if he wanted to select one of these races for his "glory," that certainly is his business. It is important for Christians to know this and to believe it. Perhaps we should go to God's word, the Bible, and see just what he has to say about his own qualifications to make such an important decision as this. Let us check him out, so to speak, and see just where he gets the authority to do this to pick a race!

Jehovah-God speaks through the Prophet [Isaiah in the 45th chapter, 12<sup>th</sup> verse](#), when he said, "I have made the earth, and created man upon it. I, even my hands, have stretched out the heavens, and all their host have I commanded." In this one verse God has created the heavens, the earth, and man; and he didn't get permission from anyone to do it...he just did it! Now, God chooses a seed, a race, a people, for in [Isaiah 43:15](#), he tells us, "I am the Lord, your Holy One, the creator of Israel, your King." And in verse three of the same chapter, God continues, "For I am the Lord thy God, the Holy One of Israel, thy Saviour <sup>1</sup>...." Israel, of course, "means the Children of Israel, the Chosen, a Seed, and not a religion. Nor was Jehovah-God speaking of a country. (political boundary) The nation of Israel as we know it today, was never so named in Biblical times. Besides, only people have saviours...not countries!

After Jehovah-God chose to make the earth, and chose to make man to have dominion over it: he then chose to work with specific individuals and tribes of mankind as we learn in:

**Isaiah 44:1-3:** "Yet now hear, O Jacob my servant, and Israel, whom I have chosen: Thus saith the Lord that made thee, and formed thee from the womb, which will help thee: Fear not, O Jacob, my servant; and thou Jesurun, whom I have chosen. For I will pour water upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground: I will pour my spirit upon thy seed, and my blessing upon thine offspring."

## "Race or Religion"

We learn from these verses that Jehovah chose Jacob, (whose name he changed to Israel) and Jacob's twelve sons and their seed. (posterity) We learn also, that he wanted this race so badly that he "formed" them in their mother's wombs. We learn too, that this race (seed) of people, which he chose, was to be his "servant" people. And of no less importance, we learn that Jehovah poured his "spirit" upon this "chosen seed." God is love...God is a spirit! It is the "Spirit of Love," which he "breathed" into his "servant" race, and which causes this "chosen" race to send Missionaries, food, clothing, medicines, and medical personnel to the "Images of God" the world over! They also fight famines, plagues, and natural disasters where ever they occur.

Folks, isn't this exciting? Here we are discovering, perhaps for the first time, that God created a special race of people (not a religion) to glorify him before the other peoples of the world. He chose Jacob (Israel) and his children. (the Israel race) for this mission! No other race of people in the world received this kind of attention from God...listen "But now thus saith the Lord that created thee, O Jacob, (Israel) and he formed thee, O Israel, Fear not: For I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name, (God did not name the Jews) thou art mine." (**Isaiah 43:1**) Nowhere in the Bible did God deal with any other race of people like this! Only his Chosen. Only the Israelites. Only the Children of Israel...Jacob's children...Jacob's seed...the CHOSEN!

Do you still question God's authority to Choose? Select? Elect? Predestinate, Discriminate? If so, then perhaps these verses in the **ninth chapter of Romans, (19-21)** will solve this problem for you:

"Thou wilt say then unto me, why doth he yet find fault? For who hath resisted his will? Nay but, O man, who art thou that repliest against God? Shall the thing formed say to him that formed it, why hast thou made me thus? (White, Black, Brown, Yellow, Red, short, tall, 75 IQ, 160 IQ, etc. etc.?) Hath not the potter power over the clay; of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, and another unto dishonour?"

As anyone knows, the potter has complete control over the clay, which he is moulding. He may choose to make a bowl, a dish, a vase, etc. they are not the same or used for the same purpose.

Therefore, God is the potter and we are the clay in his hands. He can do, and does, with us as he wishes. Now listen:

**Isaiah 43:10-11** "Ye are my witnesses, saith the Lord, and my servant who I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: Before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me."

"I, even I, am the Lord, and beside me there is no saviour."

THIS IS ONE OF THE MOST POWERFUL, AND REVEALING VERSES IN THE ENTIRE BIBLE.

Let us dissect these two verses and savor their meaning. God said, "I am the Lord." Now I see bumper stickers nearly every day on Christian's cars as well as occasional billboards which proclaim "JESUS IS LORD." If Jehovah is the Lord, (and he says that he is in the verse above) and Jesus Christ is Lord...it would logically follow then, that Jesus Christ is also God. The book of John begins with "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God;" and the 14th verse, "And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us...." We see then, that God the Father became Christ the Son; therefore the Son was the Father. You can't have one without the other. Incidentally, this is exactly what God says in:

**2 John, 1:7-13:**

*"Race or Religion"*

"For many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist. Look to yourselves, that we lose not those things which we have wrought <sup>2</sup>, but that we receive a full reward.

Whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God <sup>3</sup>. He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son.

If there come any unto you, and bring not this doctrine, receive him not into your house, neither bid him God speed;

For he that biddeth him God speed is a partaker of his evil deeds."

Ye are my witnesses," so said the Lord, speaking to ISRAEL. Now if Jesus Christ is Lord (God) and he proclaims Israel as his witness, it would logically follow then, that Israel (the seed) must be the backbone of the Christian Church today! Only those who believe that Jesus is Lord, and believe in him, are the only ones that have Jehovah-God, the Father. Only those persons, who have Jehovah-God, can be his witnesses, and only these are called by his name! Didn't I tell you that this would be exciting? Well, isn't it? The Bible is truly exciting when you rightly divide it, and this can only be done when you put the racial teaching, that runs throughout, back into the Bible where it belongs. God also said that he is our Saviour, and that there is no other...only him! We come to God the Father, through his Son, Jesus Christ. Isn't this beautiful? God said also, that he chose Israel so that they would "believe" in him, and know that "I am he." In other words, Israel would understand that he is God, the only one, and that there are no others. Upon "understanding" and "believing" these revealing facts about the Lord, Israel would then become his "servants." A Lord, or Master, has a Manor, or household in which he has servants. His "chosen" then, are not some elitist group chosen to "Lord" it over other peoples of the world; but rather chosen to be God's lowly servants who will "go where he wants them to go - say what he wants them to say - and do what he wants them to do."

God, in his own thorough way of doing things, did not leave his Chosen race to accomplish the work of witnessing by themselves. To help his Chosen in this task, he tells them in **Isaiah 45:2-4**, "I will go before thee, and make the crooked places straight: I will break in pieces the gates of brass, and cut in sunder the bars of iron and I will give them the treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places, that thou mayest know that I am the Lord, which call thee by thy name, am the God of Israel. For Jacob my servant's sake, and Israel my ELECT, I have even called thee by thy name." Not only were the Hebrews chosen they were elected! The Baptists love to sing, "Whomsoever will May Come," and certainly this is true; but according to God's word, "Whomsoever will" may not be chosen...or elected! In the book of **Ephesians (Greeks) Chapter 1**, the Apostle Paul is addressing the church (body of believers) in Ephesus, and he calls them "the faithful in Christ Jesus." In the 4th verse he states, "According as he (God) hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world..." One more scripture, I should think will be adequate to establish the fact that God is eminently qualified to choose, has the authority to choose, and in fact did choose a race of people (not religion) for his glory here on earth." Also that the posterity of this chosen seed came through Jacob, (Israel) and that there must be a remnant <sup>4</sup> of racial descendants (not religionists) alive and well in the world today! God, in **Isaiah 43:3**, admonishes his Chosen,

**"Hearken unto me, O house of Jacob, and all the remnant of the House of Israel, which are born by me from the belly, which are carried from the womb."**

If you believe the Bible to be the word of God, and if you are one who says, "GOD SAID IT...I BELIEVE IT...AND THAT SETTLES IT," then you must by now, subscribe to the following:

- 1.) That Jehovah-God is the sovereign creator of the universe.
- 2.) That Jehovah-God chose a seed in the womb for his "everlasting glory. "
- 3.) That he poured out his spirit on this chosen seed!
- 4.) That Jehovah-God chose Jacob, named him Israel, and that his twelve sons (seed) are the "Children of Israel."
- 5.) That Jehovah-God chose these Israelites "from the foundations of the earth to be God's "witnesses", and his "glory."
- 6.) That Jehovah-God, (the Lord Jesus Christ) is their Saviour.
- 7.) That there will always be a remnant of this Chosen race of Hebrew-Israelites in the world.
- 8.) That there is no other God but Jehovah, and that if you do not have his Son, Jesus Christ; you do not have Jehovah-God, his Father!
- 9.) That these Hebrew-Israelites, (the Chosen) are to be Jehovah-God's (Jesus Christ's) witnesses.
- 10.) That Jehovah-God will go before these witnesses, and pave the way for them.
- 11.) That Jehovah-God, (Christ Jesus) gave these Witnesses his name!
- 12.) That Jehovah-God chose a race of people and not a religion!

God said that he selected (elected), the seed of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, and Jacob's descendants for his "everlasting glory." He said that he will loose none of them from his hand. Therefore, they will continue to glorify him always! His remnant, the "Lost Ten Tribes of Israel," continue to do this. Presbyterians are taught to love the word "elect," and to seek it out in the scriptures, while the Baptists are taught to disdain this word, and pretend that it isn't there. The truth of the matter is that the term, "the elect," is there and the Baptists' favorite word, "whomsoever," is there also. Now how do you reconcile these two words, or terms, and make the word of God understandable, believable, and thus more powerful?

Believe it or not...it is practically the entire teaching of the Bible, and it remained obscured from me for many years. (All of the years that I depended on the "establishment" church to "feed" me God's word.) Then some years back, I felt led by the Holy Spirit to read and study the word for myself. The Bible says that "all wisdom comes from God, who gives it liberally to those who ask" So we, if we are one of his, have but to ask. We do this through prayer. We pray for it in Jesus' name!

When I started to pray to God for enlightenment, the entire Bible began to make sense to me for the first time in my entire life. Scriptures that were absolutely meaningless to me before began to literally jump out at me with a message. The more I read the more I wanted to read. The Old Testament, until then, had been to me nothing but worn out phrases, which had no relevancy to the world today. Now I spend much of my time studying it as you can see from the quotations in this work. Oh, but to go back to yesteryear when my dear Mother used to try to tell me of its wonderful teachings, and I had no desire to hear them. After a few polite moments of listening to her read from the Old Testament I would tell her that I did not care to listen to stories about Abraham, or Job, or David, or Moses, or any others. I was a New Testament man!

## *"Race or Religion"*

In Cruden's Complete Concordance of the Bible, under the word "seed" only two definitions are given: "(1) The seed of Plants. (2) The posterity of any particular man, as the seed of Abraham, referring to his descendants." Therefore, whenever you see the word seed appear in your Bible reading, it is referring to the seed of a plant, which, if placed into the ground and watered, will grow into another identical species of the plant from which it came; or on the other hand, it is referring to male sperm ("if it be Abraham's seed") which, if planted into the womb of a female penetrating her ovum (egg), a human being will grow, bearing some of the racial characteristics carried in both the male and female sperm. These are identifying marks possessed by the parents, grandparents, etc. Please keep the fact in mind at all times during this work that we are dealing with male sperm, (seed) and not plant seed, and that sperm seed means people...not spirit...not religion. More specifically, in this work we are dealing with "the seed of Abraham", his son Isaac, his son, Jacob (Israel), and the seed of his twelve sons.

There are about two full columns on seed in the concordance with about three-fourths of them pertaining to posterity. The books of Kings, Numbers, Chronicles, Genesis, Exodus, and many others are filled with genealogies, therefore you can see that blood is important to the Lord. So important in fact that he chose a race of people (the Elect) through which he would work to reveal himself to the world through the ages to follow, and who would be his glory here on earth. Abraham was the progenitor of this race, and the following scriptures pertaining to this fact have been excerpted so that the reader will have no difficulty in determining whether or not, this is true!

**GENESIS 15:3-4:** "And Abram said, behold, to me thou hast given no seed: and behold the word of the Lord came unto him, saying, This shall not be thine heir (Ishmael) but he that shall come forth out of thine own bowels shall be thine heir."

Now the key words here are "seed," "bowels," and "heir." Is there any question, but that these words denote blood...an offspring...or heir...for Abraham?

**GENESIS 17:1-2:** "And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the Lord appeared to Abram and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect, And I will make my covenant between me and thee and will multiply thee exceedingly."

**GENESIS 17:3-7:** "And Abram fell on his face: and God talked with him, saying, "As for me, behold, my covenant is with thee, and thou shalt be a father of many nations. Neither shall thy name any more be Abram; but thy name shall be Abraham: for a father of many nations have I made thee. And I will make thee exceeding fruitful, and I will make nations of thee, and kings shall come out of thee. And I will establish my covenant between me and thee and thy seed after thee in their generations for an everlasting<sup>5</sup> covenant, to be a God unto thee, and to thy seed after thee."

It is important that you file the word "everlasting" in your memory bank at this point, and believe that it means forever...without end...ad infinitum. We don't have to go to Webster's on this...do we?

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<sup>5</sup> Everlasting...to thy seed after thee," can only mean that these conditions apply, and are in effect, today...and since the "Covenant" certainly does not pertain to the "Jews", it has to pertain to ISRAEL and in force today! AND IT IS! There is only one race (seed) of people who have embraced the Father, the Son, and the Christian religion as a race, and that is the WHITE RACE! This is a fact that no amount of camouflage by the "Establishment Church" can hide!

**GENESIS 17:15-16:** "And God said unto Abraham, As for Sarai thy wife, thou shalt not call her name Sarai; but Sarah shall her name be. And I will bless her, and give thee a son also of her, and she shall be a mother of nations; kings of people shall be of her."

God changed her name, told Sarah that she would bear a son, and then follows one of the most significant teachings in the entire Bible, and undoubtedly missed by millions of Bible readers and "students" through the years. It came to light here during the process of editing this chapter. Therefore, the subsequent four paragraphs are the essence of this truth, and have been inserted into their proper place.

God made a covenant with Abraham and told him that he would be "a father of many nations." His seed did literally become many nations. Ishmael, his son by Hagar, the handmaiden, did in fact father many nations, since he was the progenitor of the numerous Arab nations. Also Abraham's sons by Keturah (whom he married after Sarah died) six in all, fathered many additional nations. Now the teaching that has been completely overlooked, as far as can be determined, is that God also made a covenant to Abraham's wife, Sarah. The Covenant is in addition to the one made with Abraham that was fulfilled by Ishmael's seed, and the seed of his other sons by Keturah. This was a covenant that pertained to Sarah only, in that God promised her that "she shall be a mother of many nations and Kings of people shall be of her." Sarah had only one child, a son named Isaac, and then she died. Therefore the "nations and kings" promised her by God could only come from her son Isaac. The Apostle Paul stated this Truth some 2000 years later in Romans 9:7, "Neither, because they are the seed of Abraham (Ishmael, etc.) are they all children: but in Isaac shall thy seed be called." God's "Chosen," or "Elect" then, shall come only from Isaac's seed, and that his seed only, to become "many nations and kings." IF THE JEWS ARE THE "CHOSEN," THEY MUST COME FROM ISAAC'S SEED, AND BECOME MANY NATIONS! WHERE ARE ALL OF THESE NATIONS?

We know then, that Isaac had twin sons, Esau and Jacob, and that God chose Jacob over Esau to continue the racial seed for his "Chosen" people. Jacob, whose name was changed by God to "ISRAEL," fathered twelve sons who, in turn, fathered the "Twelve Tribes of Israel" (Jacob). The Bible only records two nations, the Northern Kingdom of Israel, and the Southern Kingdom of Judah, (Judea) as having been founded by these twelve tribes. Does two mean "MANY?" Can it even be construed as such? I think not! Therefore, in the ensuing 2500 years, there simply has to be "many nations, and kings," formed by Jacob's seed through his sons (the Twelve Tribes of Israel) for this specific condition of God's Covenant to Sarah to have been fulfilled. Can God lie? No!

Now if the Jews are God's Chosen, as most pastors in our "Establishment Churches" boldly proclaim, the Jews would have to be Israel, and as such would have to trace their lineage back to one of these Twelve Tribes of Israel, (Jacob) and subsequently to one of these two nations. Where, then, are all of the "many" nations of Jews with Kings, that would have to had existed in history and be in existence presently? The Jews, in fact, have not even had a nation since the fall of Jerusalem to Titus in 70 A.D., until 1948, when parts of Palestine were given them by a United Nations decree. They named the country Israel, and now everyone who lives there is an "Israelite" by residence, not seed-the same conditions extant in Jesus' day with the exception that they were called "Jews" because they lived in Judea. However, the Bible does not say that God chose a geographical location for his "glory". He chose a seed-a race of people, and scattered them among the other nations of the earth. This covenant of God's to Sarah, through Abraham, was "everlasting" and as such must be in existence today. Certainly all but the "blinded" can see that the Jews do not, and have not ever, fulfilled God's promise to Sarah, and became "many nations and kings."

Another scripture from the ninth chapter of Romans, verse 6, should be of great interest here to serious Biblical students: "Not as though the word of God hath taken none effect. For they are not all Israel which are of Israel." This verse means just what it says...Jesus tells us that not all of the people who claim to be Israelites simply because they married one, or that their children were of an Israelite, does not make them of the blood line of the "Children of Israel." If this was true then Ishmael, whose father was Abraham was a full-blooded Hebrew would have been an "Israelite"...but he wasn't! The bloodline, by Divine intervention and guidance, was passed through both Abraham and Sarah, in their Son, ISAAC. God chose Rebecca, a relative of Abraham's as a wife for Isaac, thus keeping the bloodline coming through both parents. After God chose their son Jacob over Esau, God continued to be the matchmaker, and sent Jacob over to obtain a wife from his mother's brother whose name was Laban. (It is interesting here to know that "LABAN" is the Hebrew word for "WHITE.")

Another pertinent verse is found in [Revelation 2:9](#), and again our Lord is speaking: "...and I know the blasphemy of them which say they are Jews, and are not, but are the synagogue of Satan."

Since Jesus has already told us above that "they are not all Israel who say they are of Israel, the Chosen Race of God, and since I believe him to be God Incarnate, it follows that he has the ultimate vocabulary. In it he has the terms "HEBREW", "ISRAEL," and "JEW." He knows that they each have different meanings and has used them correctly in numerous scriptures. Therefore, I could see the incongruity of the above scripture immediately; because our LORD had already told these "JEWS" that their "father was the devil who was a liar from the beginning..." SO how, would it be blasphemy to claim to be a "JEW?"

THE WORD "JEW" USED HERE BY THE TRANSLATORS HAD TO BE THE WRONG WORD. THE WORD "ISRAEL" SHOULD HAVE BEEN USED HERE AND HAD IT BEEN, IT WOULD RELAY THE SAME MESSAGE AS JESUS GAVE US IN [ROMANS 6](#): AND WOULD READ THUSLY:

"I know the blasphemy of them which say they are ISRAEL and are not, but are the synagogue of Satan."

Strong's Exhaustive Concordance gives us the number #2453 as being the word translated "Jew." The word is "CHAKMOWNIY" (Khak-Mo-Nee) "from #2449, skilful, chokmoni, an Israelite." (Perhaps the term "skilful" confused the interpreters, and they used the term "Jew.")

Thus far we have seen that God changed the names of both Abraham and Sarah. Abraham was ninety-nine years old when he heard this promise of the Lord, and he "fell upon his face and laughed," because he just couldn't believe that it was true. As you will later see in scripture, God also selected Isaac for the child's name...which means "laughter." Then in the [19th verse](#), God told Abraham, "Sarah, thy wife, shall bear thee a son indeed; and thou shalt call his name Isaac: and I will establish my covenant with him for an everlasting covenant, and with his seed after him."

Both Sarah and Abraham are concerned about Ishmael, (the child of Sarah's hand-maid of whom Abraham was the father), and God told them that he will bless Ishmael and multiply his seed exceedingly: "But my covenant will I establish with Isaac, which Sarah shall bear unto thee at this set time in the next year." All of the words "seed" are underlined for the reader's attention, and they all refer sperm and ovum-posterity! Not plants, and not religion! Is there any doubt in your mind that God is dealing with a specific bloodline and not a religion? I certainly hope so; but if there is any doubt still in your mind at this point Jehovah-God should nail it

down in the **21st verse** wherein he tells us: "**But-my-covenant will I establish with Isaac**, which Sarah shall bear at this set time next year."

Still in chapter 21, God delivers his promise, "For Sarah conceived and bare Abraham a son in his old age, in the set time of which God has spoken to him." And later in the same chapter God told Abraham, I in all that Sarah hath said unto thee, harken unto her voice; **for in Isaac shall thy seed be called.**" So we see here the seed that God planted was not garden seed; but his sperm which he implanted within Sarah's womb piercing her ovum, and thus Little Isaac was born. Just the way God planned it! And furthermore, according to the Covenant which God made with ISRAEL, and found recorded in the **35th chapter of Jeremiah**, ISRAEL WILL ALWAYS EXIST: "as long as the sun is in the sky, and the moon and stars give off their light at night" Israel will always be God's chosen people, and he will always be their God."

We should keep in mind always that God cannot lie. He is not devious, and he does not have a human nature even though mankind continues to attempt to reduce him to their own thoughts, perspectives, understandings, and conjectures with such paltry utterances as "the Old Man upstairs", etc. In the book of Genesis (Latin=birth, generation.) God "forms," "Elects," selects, names, and Shepherds a bloodline people, who as a race, will carry out his purpose on planet earth. He chose Abraham, Sarah, their son Isaac, and Isaac's Son (Saacs – son = Sacson = Saxon), Jacob's twelve sons (Jacobson) as the progenitors of his "Chosen Race", and if God's Word is True, they have to be well and prosperous today, and he must be their God, and they his people! It is as simple as that, folks!

As most of you know, Isaac, as a young boy was offered as a sacrifice by Abraham; (**Gen. 22:7**); but God intervened and provided a "scape goat." In **Genesis 24:51**, Isaac married Rebecca, and in verse 60, "...they blessed Rebekah, and said unto her, Thou art our sister, be thou the mother of thousands of millions;<sup>6</sup> and let thy seed possess the gate<sup>7</sup> of those which hate them..." We have underlined the word seed again to keep you in tune with God's promise, and the "thousands of millions", to emphasize the fact that from this union, Rebekah and Isaac, would spring billions of people, and a good portion of them heirs to the promise<sup>8</sup>, and the "Elect" of God.

Most every Christian is familiar with the story just told between Isaac and Ishmael, and how Jehovah-God chose Isaac for his "promised seed." However it was not only Ishmael that was passed up because in the **25th chapter of Genesis**, Abraham took another wife, after Sarah died, whose name was Keturah, "and she bare him Zimran, and Jokshan, and Medan, and Midian, and Ishbak, and Shuah." Abraham gave them gifts, and sent them away from Isaac, and he gave Isaac "all that he had."<sup>9</sup> Although all of these were children of Abraham, only "in Isaac shall thy seed be called." This means simply that Abraham had a number of children with both Hagar and Keturah; but only in Isaac (Laughter)<sup>10</sup> the child of Abraham and Sarah, was "thy seed called."

God's covenant with Abraham pertaining to "seed" which has become known as the "Abrahamic Covenant", should be technically called, "The Abraham-Sarah-Isaac-Jacob Covenant," since they are all a part of it! God also made a promise regarding Ishmael, which contained at least a portion of the same promise that he made

with Abraham pertaining to the propagation of his posterity. The CHOSEN RACE then, are the blood descendants of the ABRAHAM-SARAH-ISAAC-JACOB COVENANT. Yet many of our preachers and teachers deny this fact, because they do not teach that the "Abrahamic Covenant" is everlasting, or that the Jacob-Israel people in the Bible are different from the Jews.

Thus far we have covered the Lord's calling of Abraham, and his son, Isaac. The third member of this triangular covenant is Isaac's son, Jacob. Isaac married Rebekah when he was forty years old, and in the **25th chapter of Genesis**, we are told "And Isaac entreated the Lord for his wife, because she was barren: and the Lord was entreated of him, and Rebekah his wife conceived." This is one of the most interesting stories in the Bible as it covers this conception, which turned out to be twins. (Remember, God caused this conception) Remember also, that God had chosen Isaac over Ishmael, his older half-brother.

You will see that he chose the younger of these two. In the **23<sup>rd</sup> verse** we find "And the Lord said unto her, (Rebekah) Two nations are in thy whom, and two manner of people <sup>11</sup> shall be separated from thy bowels; and the one people shall be stronger than the other people; and the elder shall serve the younger." It should be noted again, that the words womb, bowels, and people, mean that God is not talking about plants. God is dealing with the seed of man! Also observe that God is forming two nations here, not one, and that the older (Esau) will serve the younger (Jacob). Can God discriminate? Yes, he certainly can! Did he? Yes, he most certainly did! First, he said that "two manner of people" were in Rebekah's womb. Webster's give this definition of "manner." "A way of acting; personal, esp. customary, behavior or bearing, ways of social life, etc." It would seem then, that we are not all created equal, at least in God's eyes and his ways of doing things.

A second form of discrimination is contained in the verse above as God said that the "elder would serve the younger." This of course, is the utmost discrimination. You see, God can, and does, do whatever he deems necessary to affect his plan here on earth. The 25th verse tells how Esau came first in the birth, and then the 26th verse reveals another miracle: "And after that came his brother out, and his hand took hold on Esau's heel; and his name was called Jacob..." Through the next several verses Jacob and Esau grew to maturity, and we find Esau taking a wife from among the daughters of the Hittites! (A no-no with God) His mother, Rebekah is upset with him and told Isaac, that "If Jacob take a wife of the daughters of Heth, such as these which are of the daughters of the land, what good will my life do me?"

So in the **28th chapter, verse 1**, Isaac told Jacob,

"Thou shalt not take a wife of the daughters of Canaan. Arise, go to Pedan-a-ram, to the house of Bethuel thy mother's father; and take thee a wife from thence of the daughters of Laban, (Hebrew = white) thy mother's brother."
